## A note on liturgical colors:

**Green:** Ordinary Time

**Purple:** Advent and Lent

**Rose:** Gaudete Sunday (third Sunday of Advent) and Laetere Sunday (fourth Sunday in Lent)

**Red:** Holy Spirit and martyrdom: Palm Sunday, Good Friday, and Pentecost Sunday; celebrations of the Lord's Passion, of Apostles, and of Evangelists; celebrations of Martyrs

**White:** Christmas and Easter seasons: as well as the celebrations of the Lord (except of his Passion), of Our Lady, of the Angels, and of Saints who were not Martyrs.

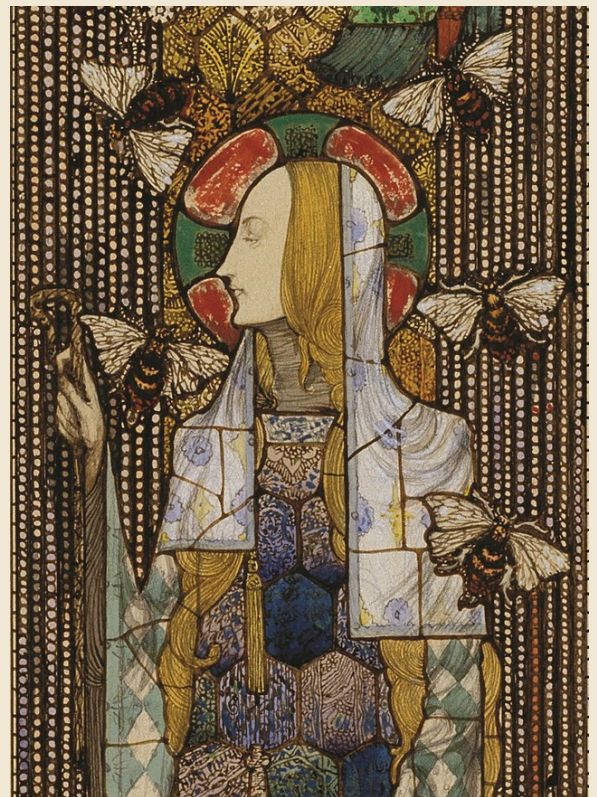
Also used for the solemnities of the Most Holy Trinity (Sun. after Pentecost), of All Saints (Nov. 1), and of the Nativity of St. John the Baptist (June 24) and the feasts of the Conversion of St. Paul (Jan. 25), of the Chair of St. Peter (Feb. 22), and of St. John (Dec. 27)

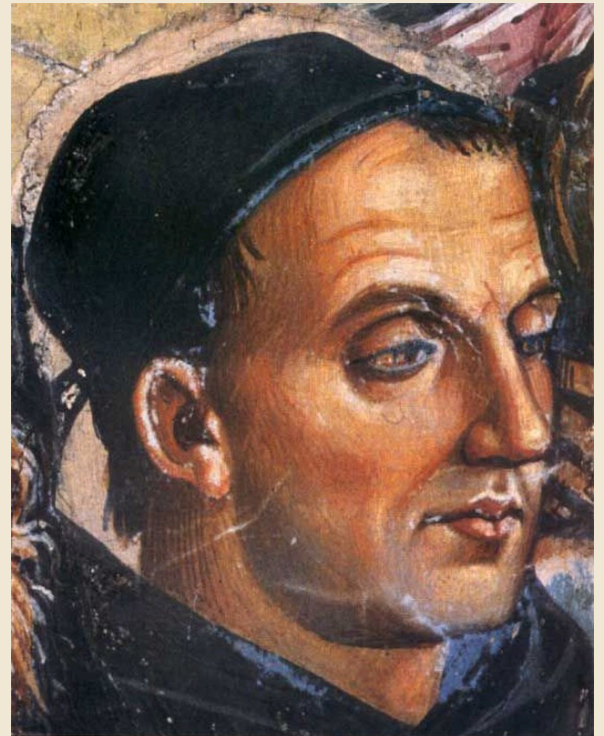
